**6 local institutions** will lose **52 awards** and  
subcontracts worth at least **\$977 million**

## **AL Burlington**

**TETRA TECH/ARD** lost 29 awards worth \$788 million to advance global food security, conserve natural resources, promote access to safe water and sanitation, and secure legal ownership or title to land for rural populations

**RESONANCE** lost 15 awards worth \$71 million to promote win-win partnerships with the private sector around the world, make USAID operations and programs more efficient using digital technologies, and provide specialized staffing support

**THINKMD** lost a \$1.5 million award to investigate how their innovative technology can help overworked and under-skilled healthcare workers provide better care for patients in poor and rural communities in Africa

## **AL Waterbury**

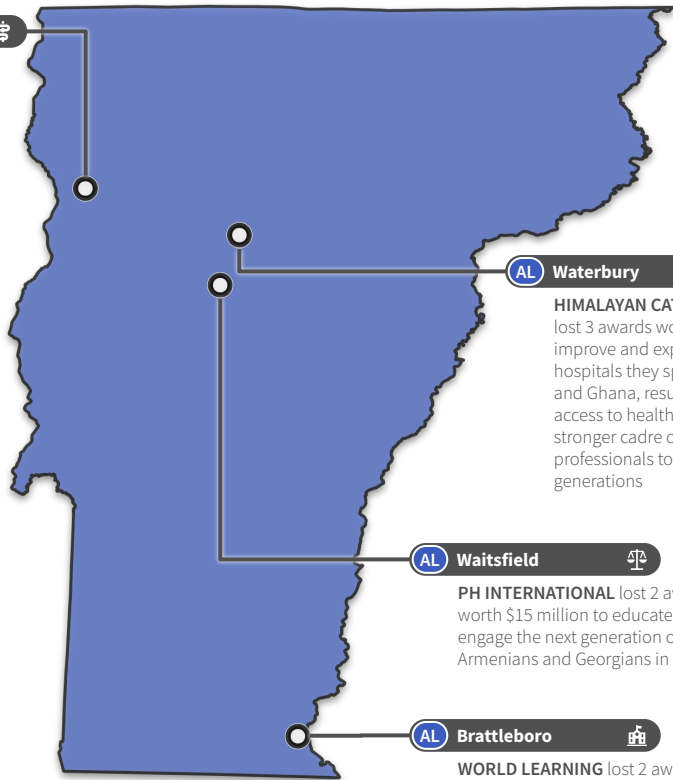
**HIMALAYAN CATARACT PROJECT** lost 3 awards worth \$1.5 million to improve and expand teaching hospitals they sponsor in Nepal and Ghana, resulting in greater access to healthcare and a stronger cadre of health professionals to care for future generations

**PH INTERNATIONAL** lost 2 awards worth \$15 million to educate and engage the next generation of Armenians and Georgians in civic life

## **AL Brattleboro**

**WORLD LEARNING** lost 2 awards worth \$100 million to improve learning outcomes for students in primary school around the world as well as to bring together professionals from Belarus with U.S. counterparts through tailored professional exchanges
