


USAID Cuts Hit Home in **NEBRASKA**

3 local institutions will lose **8 awards** and subcontracts worth at least **\$94 million**



Growers of beans, peas, and lentils
will lose as much as **20%** of their market



SOCHA LLC lost 6 awards worth \$65 million to support USAID planning based on data and evidence of what works

UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA
lost 2 awards worth \$29 million to operate the **Feed the Future Innovation Lab for Irrigation and Mechanization Systems**

GENESEEK lost awards in which they contributed world-class technology and expertise in animal breeding, such as the **Innovation Lab for Genomics to Improve Poultry** led by University of California, Davis
