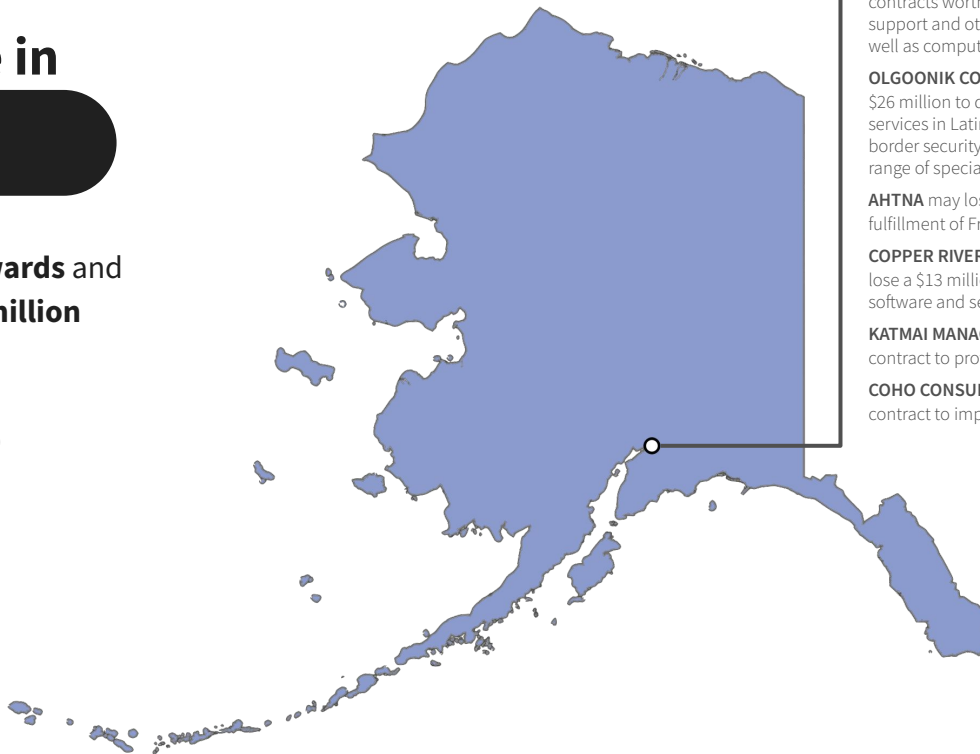


USAID Cuts Hit Home in **ALASKA**

7 local institutions will lose **25 awards** and subcontracts worth at least **\$219 million**

CHUGACH GOVERNMENT SOLUTIONS lost 4 contracts worth \$98 million to provide a range of specialized staffing support

KONIAG GOVERNMENT SERVICES may lose 8 contracts worth \$60 million to deliver mental health support and other assistance for USAID personnel as well as computer software and services

OLGOONIK CORPORATION lost 9 contracts worth \$26 million to deliver technical assistance and advisory services in Latin America, including strengthening border security in Colombia, as well as to provide a range of specialized staffing support

AHTNA may lose a \$13 million contract to support fulfillment of Freedom of Information Act requests

COPPER RIVER INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY may lose a \$13 million contract to provide computer software and services

KATMAI MANAGEMENT SERVICES lost a \$5.7 million contract to provide moving and storage services

COHO CONSULTING GROUP lost a \$5.3 million contract to improve systems for financial management
