


USAID Cuts Hit Home in COLORADO

18 local institutions will lose
more than 88 awards and subcontracts
worth at least \$255 million

-  \$177 million from 73 contracts with 10 companies
-  \$53 million from 15 awards to 4 non-profit organizations
-  \$24 million from multiple subawards with 2 universities



2 Fort Collins 

COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY lost at least 1 subaward in which they contributed their unique capabilities to the **Horticulture Innovation Lab** led by University of California, Davis

BOULDER COUNTY

2 institutions lost multiple awards worth at least \$24 million

2 Boulder 

UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO BOULDER lost multiple subawards worth at least \$24 million in which they applied their world-class expertise, such as the **Sustainable Intensification Innovation Lab** led by Kansas State University

2 Longmont 

SF&B lost a \$14k contract for computer equipment

1 Denver 

INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT ENTERPRISES lost 13 awards worth \$31 million to improve agriculture and sanitation in Africa and Asia

OPTIV FEDERAL lost a \$185k award for computer software and services

CAUSAL DESIGN lost subawards worth \$45 million to make USAID programs more efficient and effective using data and evidence

MARKETSHARE ASSOCIATES lost multiple subawards worth \$13 million to assess and improve programs for farmers and businesses

VIETNAM HEALTH IMPROVEMENT PROJECT lost a subaward to support people with disabilities in areas sprayed with Agent Orange

CR ENERGY CONCEPTS lost a \$1.2 million award connected to their \$200 million direct investment in renewable energy in Africa

TRANSLATION EXCELLENCE lost 2 awards worth \$792k for language interpretation

JUBA VALLEY DEVELOPMENT lost a \$55k award to deliver humanitarian assistance

7 Arvada 

COUNTERTRADE PRODUCTS lost 61 awards worth \$71 million for computer equipment

7 Golden 

PHARMAJET lost a \$1.5 million award to evaluate a new device to deliver injections without needles

RURAL AREAS STATEWIDE 

FARMERS are losing reliable markets for crops. It's difficult to estimate the direct impact for Colorado, but every year USAID purchased about 1 million tons from U.S. growers and spent \$2 billion to provide food aid

ARTICUS SOLUTIONS lost a \$25 million award for staffing support

V3GATE LLC lost 3 awards worth \$15 million for computer software

2MATOE LLC lost a \$4 million award to monitor computer network operations
