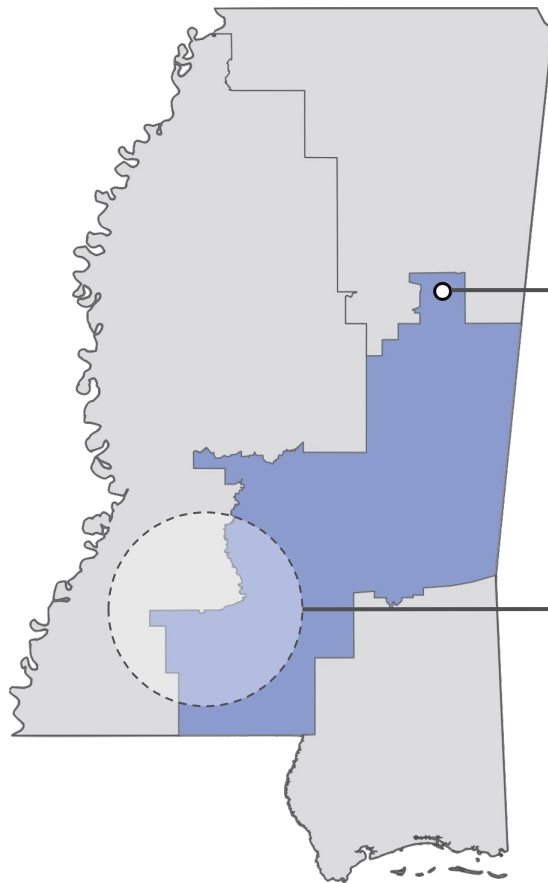


USAID Cuts Hit Home in MISSISSIPPI
