



USAID Cuts Hit Home in NORTH CAROLINA

14 local institutions will lose more than **133 awards** and subcontracts worth at least **\$6.7 billion**



RESEARCH TRIANGLE | 8 institutions will lose 115 awards worth \$6.6 billion

2 Durham



FH 360 lost 73% of their 60 awards worth \$4.3 billion to control the spread of disease (especially HIV and TB), improve child nutrition, promote education, boost citizen engagement in other countries, and improve economic and food security

ORGANIZATION FOR TROPICAL STUDIES

lost a \$693k award to expand access to higher education

DUKE UNIVERSITY lost multiple subawards to apply their world-class expertise to solve a range of problems in the developing world

2 Research Triangle Park



RTI lost 96% of their 44 awards worth \$2 billion to control disease, promote education, and secure livelihoods for the world's poorest

2 Chapel Hill



UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA lost 3 awards worth \$186 million to assess and evaluate what works in global health

INTRAHEALTH lost 75% of their 4 awards worth \$123 million primarily to sustain HIV treatment



NORTH CAROLINA STATE UNIVERSITY lost a \$2 million award to boost incomes for textile producers in Central America

RURAL AREAS STATEWIDE

FARMERS & WHOLESALERS are losing reliable markets for their crops

It's difficult to estimate the direct impact for North Carolina, but every year USAID purchased about 1 million tons from U.S. growers and spent \$2 billion to provide food aid
