

USAID Cuts Hit Home in GEORGIA

17 local institutions will lose over **73 awards** and subcontracts worth at least **\$952 million**



\$834 million from 60 awards to 7 **non-profit organizations**



\$73 million from 7 contracts with 5 **companies**



\$43 million from 4 awards with 2 **universities**



\$853,000 from 2 awards to 2 **faith-based organizations**

CARE lost 68% of their 40 awards worth \$710 million to provide humanitarian assistance, improve child health, reduce malnutrition and food insecurity, promote education especially for girls, and boost livelihoods for the most vulnerable and marginalized communities around the world

GSMA MOBILE FOR DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION lost a \$23 million award to expand access to and use of digital technologies in Africa and Asia

CARTER CENTER lost 2 awards worth \$19 million to eradicate river blindness in the Americas and to promote women's rights in Bangladesh

AT&T MOBILITY lost 97% of their 2 contracts worth \$13 million for mobile telecommunications

EARTH UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION lost a \$979k award to strengthen the university they sponsor in Costa Rica

EMORY UNIVERSITY lost at least \$900k in subawards to apply their world-class expertise in public health

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY lost a \$900k award to research humanitarian shelter and settlements

MANRRS lost a \$200k award to train the next generation of leaders tackling poverty, hunger, and malnutrition

VERNONBURG GROUP lost a \$55 million award to expand internet access in low- and middle-income countries

MANA NUTRITION lost a third of their 14 awards worth \$36 million for the specialized manufacture of an effective therapy for malnourished children made from peanuts and other ingredients grown in the U.S.

HEART FOR AFRICA may lose a \$92k award to deliver humanitarian aid

MAGNET FORENSICS may lose 2 awards worth \$1.1 million for computer software

FARMERS are losing reliable markets for their crops
