


USAID Cuts Hit Home in OKLAHOMA

5 local institutions will lose 5 awards and subcontracts worth at least \$55 million

- **\$30 million** from 2 awards to 2 **non-profit organization**
- **\$25 million** from 2 contracts with 2 **companies**
- **1 university** lost multiple subawards of unknown value
